In recent years, scholarship recipients have cancelled their attendance due to scheduling conflicts. It is very important that if your application is accepted that all potential scheduling conflicts are resolved ahead of time. There are many individuals who apply for these scholarships, and when scholarship recipients do not attend, it takes the opportunity away from other applicants.

ARTE Scholars are <u>required to participate in all general sessions as well as the Aesthetic</u> <u>Summit for the New Practitioner spanning from Friday January 18, 2019 through Monday</u> <u>January 21, 2019</u>. Each scholar will be required to sign in for each session they attend and complete all session-related surveys or questionnaires. Please ensure that your travel plans accommodate your full attendance Friday January 18th through Monday, January 21st.*
