# Mentee Facts-at-a-Glance

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

Research from ODAC indicates many dermatology residents lack the requisite mentorship which would provide ongoing, real time guidance and support during residency and beyond. In response to this ever-increasing need, the Resident Career Development Mentorship Program will offer five dermatology residents the opportunity to connect one-on-one with leaders in the various areas of dermatology through a mentor-mentee relationship. As a Resident Career Development Mentee, you will be paired with a leading dermatology physician (part of the ODAC 2019 presenting faculty) and will meet with your mentor in a series of virtual and live meetings where you will discuss your specialty interests and career goals.

You will have the opportunity to meet with other ODAC faculty members while onsite at ODAC, January 18-21, 2019 and you will attend your mentor's lectures and report on these and other lectures. Your written summaries will be selected for publication on the Next Steps in Derm platform (https://nextstepsinderm.com/) and you will receive an author byline. Additionally, you will attend the live Resident Career Development Mentee panel discussion on Sunday, January 20 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM.

### **RESPONSIBILITIES OF MENTEES:**

- Connect with mentor prior to ODAC 2019
- Develop questions for your mentor in advance of personal meetings during ODAC
- Meet virtually with your mentor prior to ODAC 2019
- Meet with your mentor in Orlando during ODAC in a one-on-one setting
- Attend and review at least one of your mentor's ODAC presentations as well as other relevant ODAC sessions
- Interview at least one other non-mentor ODAC faculty member
- Write a summary of the presentation(s) you attend for submission for publication on the Next Steps in Derm platform. (You will be provided with the Next Steps in Derm Content Contributor Onboarding document to better understand content, style and readability guidelines).
- Attend the live Resident Career Development Mentorship Program panel discussion on Sunday, January 20 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM

## PROGRAM INCLUSIONS:

The Resident Career Development Mentorship Program will provide each mentee with the following:

- ODAC 2019 registration (at no charge)
- Reimbursement for one round-trip, coach class airline ticket (receipts required).
   Airline reservations must be made no later than December 20, 2018.
- Roundtrip ground transfers between the Orlando International Airport and the JW Marriott (not to exceed \$60)
- Up to 3 nights lodging at the JW Marriott (shared occupancy with same resident assigned through ARTE program)
- Author byline for our summary reports accepted for publication on the Next Steps in Derm platform

### APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete online application and submit all required materials by November 30, 2018 at 5:00 PM EDT
- Provide current curriculum vitae
- Provide letter of good standing from Residency
   Program Director
- Provide current medical or training license number (including state of licensure and expiration date), and current NPI number, if applicable
- Provide a 500-word letter of intent or letter of motivation. Applicants are encouraged to submit other samples of professional writing or published papers. Please include a summary of your research and clinical areas of specialization

Note: Incomplete applications will automatically be removed from the selection process and application revisions will not be accepted.

- Mentors and Mentees introduced via email by December 17, 2018
- Mentors and Mentees meet virtually between December 18, 2018-January 16, 2019
- Airline reservations to be made no later than December 20, 2018
- Personal, onsite meetings during ODAC,
   January 18-21, 2019
- Attend and summarize selected presentations during ODAC, January 18-21, 2019
- Resident Leader in Dermatology Mentorship panel discussion on Sunday, January 20, 2019 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM
