BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Research from ODAC indicates many dermatology residents lack the requisite mentorship which would provide ongoing, real time guidance and support during residency and beyond. In response to this ever-increasing need, the Young Dermatology Leader Mentorship Program will offer seven dermatology residents the opportunity to connect one-on-one with leaders in the various areas of dermatology through a mentor-mentee relationship. As a Young Dermatology Leader Mentee, you will be paired with a leading dermatology physician (part of the ODAC 2020 presenting faculty) and will meet with your mentor in a series of virtual and live meetings where you will discuss your specialty interests and career goals.

You will have the opportunity to meet with other ODAC faculty members while onsite at ODAC, January 17-20, 2020 and attend your mentor's lectures and report on these and other assigned lectures. Your written summaries will be selected for publication on the Next Steps in Derm platform (https://nextstepsinderm.com/) and you will receive an author byline. Additionally, you will attend the live Young Dermatology Leader Mentorship Program panel discussion on Sunday, January 19 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Live panel time is subject to change.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF MENTEES:

- Connect with mentor prior to ODAC 2020
- Develop questions for your mentor in advance of personal meetings during ODAC
- Meet virtually with your mentor prior to ODAC 2020
- Meet with your mentor in Orlando during ODAC in a one-on-one setting
- Review mentor's presentations in full and attend other assigned presentations
- Interview at least one other non-mentor ODAC faculty member
- Write a summary of the presentation(s) you attend for submission for publication on the Next Steps in Derm platform. (You will be provided with the Next Steps in Derm Content Contributor Onboarding document to better understand content, style and readability guidelines).
- Obtain written approval from mentor and non-mentor for all write-ups prior to publication.
- Complete and return a content release form for each write-up
- Attend the live Young Dermatology Leader Mentorship Program panel discussion on Sunday, January 19 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Panel time subject to change.

PROGRAM INCLUSIONS:

The Young Dermatology Leader Mentorship Program will provide each mentee with the following:

- ODAC 2020 registration (at no charge)
- Reimbursement for one round-trip, coach class airline ticket (receipts required). Airline reservations must be made no later than December 20, 2019.
- Roundtrip ground transfers between the Orlando International Airport and the JW Marriott, using the ground transportation option provided by PCE (to be confirmed after your airline reservations are confirmed). You will not be reimbursed for taxi, Uber/Lyft or other forms of ground transportation not organized by PCE.
- Up to 3 nights lodging at the JW Marriott (single occupancy).
- Author byline for your summary reports accepted for publication on the Next Steps in Derm platform

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete online application and submit all required materials by December 10, 2019 at 5:00 PM EDT
- Provide current curriculum vitae
- Provide letter of good standing from Residency Program Director
- Provide current medical or training license number (including state of licensure and expiration date), and current NPI number, if applicable
- Provide a 500-word letter of intent or letter of motivation. Applicants are encouraged to submit other samples of professional writing or published papers. Please include a summary of your research and clinical areas of specialization

Note: Incomplete applications will automatically be removed from the selection process and application revisions will not be accepted.

- Application deadline is December 10, 2019
- Mentees confirmed by December 11, 2019
- Mentors and Mentees introduced via email by December 17, 2019
- Mentors and Mentees meet virtually between December 18, 2019-January 16, 2020
- Airline reservations to be made no later than December 20, 2019
- Personal, onsite meetings during ODAC, January 17 – 20, 2020
- Attend and summarize selected presentations during ODAC, January 17 – 20, 2020
- Young Dermatology Leader Mentorship Program panel discussion on Sunday, January 19, 2020 from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Panel time subject to change.
